PETER GUADION'S BLUES EXPRESS

Trumpeter-vocalist Peter Gaudion is one of Australia's leading players in the traditional-mainstream styles. Going back to his early days with Frank Traynor's Jazz Preachers, then with the long-running band The Syncopators, and his own band the Blues Express, Peter has always been known for the fire and power of his trumpet playing, as well as his

relaxed singing and irreverent sense of humor. Among the international artists he has performed with are Ralph Sutton, Jimmy Witherspoon and Kenny Ball.

The current version of the Blues Express features the great Bob Sedergreen on piano, Peter's son Ash Gaudion on alto sax and vocals, along with James Macaulay (trombone), James Clark (bass) and Rod Gilbert (drums); and special guest, Jackie Gaudion on vocals.

GEOFF KLUKE & THE CHANGES

One of the elder statesmen of the bass in Australian jazz, Geoff Kluke began his career in Adelaide in the late '60s. A move to Melbourne in the early '80s gave him a wider range of opportunities as both a player and teacher.

Geoff's cv is remarkable. He has worked with many of the leading artists in Australian jazz, including Brian Browne, Bob Sedergreen, Allan Browne, Tony Gould, Serge Ermoll, Don Burrows and Ted Nettelbeck. Among the many visiting soloists he has played with: Phil Woods, Mark Murphy, Nat Adderley, Lee Konitz, George Cables and Clifford Jordan.

In recent years, Geoff has recorded some of his original compositions, on *Valley Road* and *Like It Is*. Both CDs feature some of Geoff's contemporaries on the Melbourne scene, and some of his favourite younger-generation players.

For this concert, Geoff will be joined by Bob Sedergreen (piano), Peter Petrucci (guitar), Mike Jordan (drums), and Wilbur Wilde and Paul Williamson (saxophones).

BLACK JESUS EXPERIENCE

BLACK JESUS EXPERIENCE (BJX) is an 8-piece band playing an irresistibly danceable blend of traditional Ethiopian song and 21st Century groove. Drawing together immigrants from five nations, the band and its music reflects the multicultural vibrancy of Melbourne and Australia.

Singer Enushu began entertaining her local community as a child in Addis Ababa. Forced to leave Ethiopia, Enushu migrated to Australia bringing hauntingly beautiful compositions inspired by her remarkable life story and the unique vocal traditions of Ethiopia. Enushu is joined on vocals by poetic giant and lyrical miracle Mr Monk, Zimbabwe born and Outback bred.

Saxophonist Peter Harper and trumpeter Ian Dixon have played jazz and jazz-based improv over many years, in bands like Musiikki Oy and Blow.

When not touring, BJX run a weekly session at cultural hub The Horn creating new songs live on stage featuring guest artists from all walks of life. The comfort BJX has with this practice lies in the improvising traditions of Hip Hop, Jazz, Azmari and Funk.

BJX's fourth album 'Migration' won 'The Age-Music Victoria Best Global Album 2014' award. Other awards for BJX include 'Most Outstanding Performance Troupe Of The Year, African Australian National Awards 2013' Highlights for BJX include two tours of "the Motherland" Ethiopia, performing with Ethiojazz legend Mulatu Astatke in Europe and Australia (an association which won BJX and Mulatu 'The Age Best National Tour 2013' award), Glastonbury and other great festivals.

The rhymes and chimes of Black Jesus Experience deliver the power and beauty of Africa through the vocal prism of Hip-Hop and freedom of Funk.

"Black Jesus Experience created a warm and potent ensemble sound blending Afro-Latin rhythms, improvised jazz solos and the exotic five tone scales that are integral to Ethiopian music. 
